The General Assembly is the supreme decision-making body of the NCD Alliance.

Composed of NCD Alliance members, the NCD Alliance General Assembly is the organisation's supreme decision-making body. The GA meets every two years, and elects NCD Alliance's President and Board. It can amend the constitution and receives and adopts the Alliance's reports and financial accounts.

There are four founding members of the NCD Alliance: [International Diabetes Federation](#) [1], [World Heart Federation](#) [2], [Union for International Cancer Control](#) [3] and [The Union](#) [3]. Founding members can vote at the General Assembly and can nominate individuals for election as NCD Alliance President and Board members. In addition, founding members are entitled to a permanent seat on the Board.

Full NCD Alliance members are entitled to attend and vote at the GA and can nominate individuals for President / Board. Associate members can attend the GA as observers (but not vote) and can nominate individuals for the Board (not for President).

The first NCD Alliance General Assembly was held on 22 May 2017, in Geneva.
